

not inevitable and that, given the determination it can be wiped out.

The changes which social institutions and values are undergoing will affect everyone and especially the Hindus as Hinduism is dependent on institutions which are changing in important ways. This is a matter of concern because it is necessary to provide the younger generation with a sense of purpose and of values.

Then he said that equating the western world view with the scientific or rational world view and this is not quite legitimate. The western world view is clearly more scientific and technologically advanced western countries excluding Russia.

Then he said about the 'promise of progress' with the third Five year plan, India enters the most momentous decade of her development. Today's battlegrounds are in the steel works and mines, the very foundations of our economic growth.

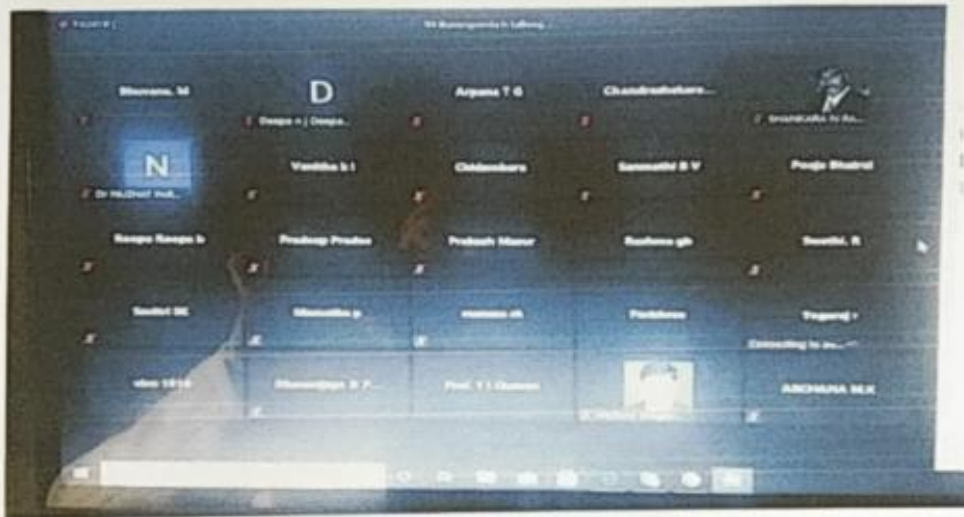
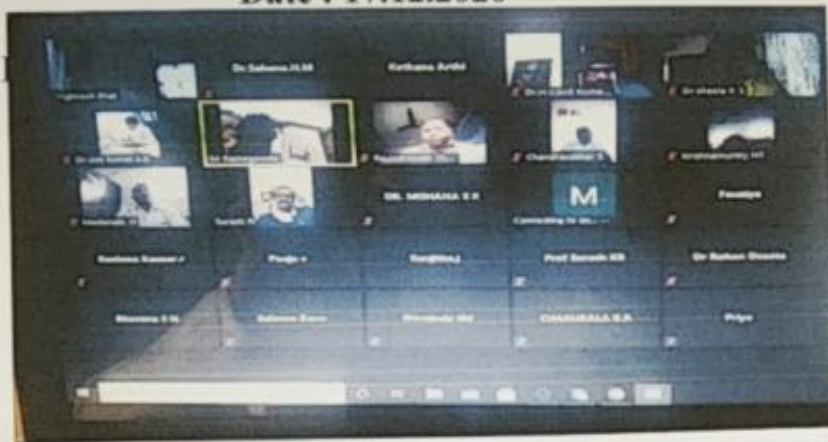
