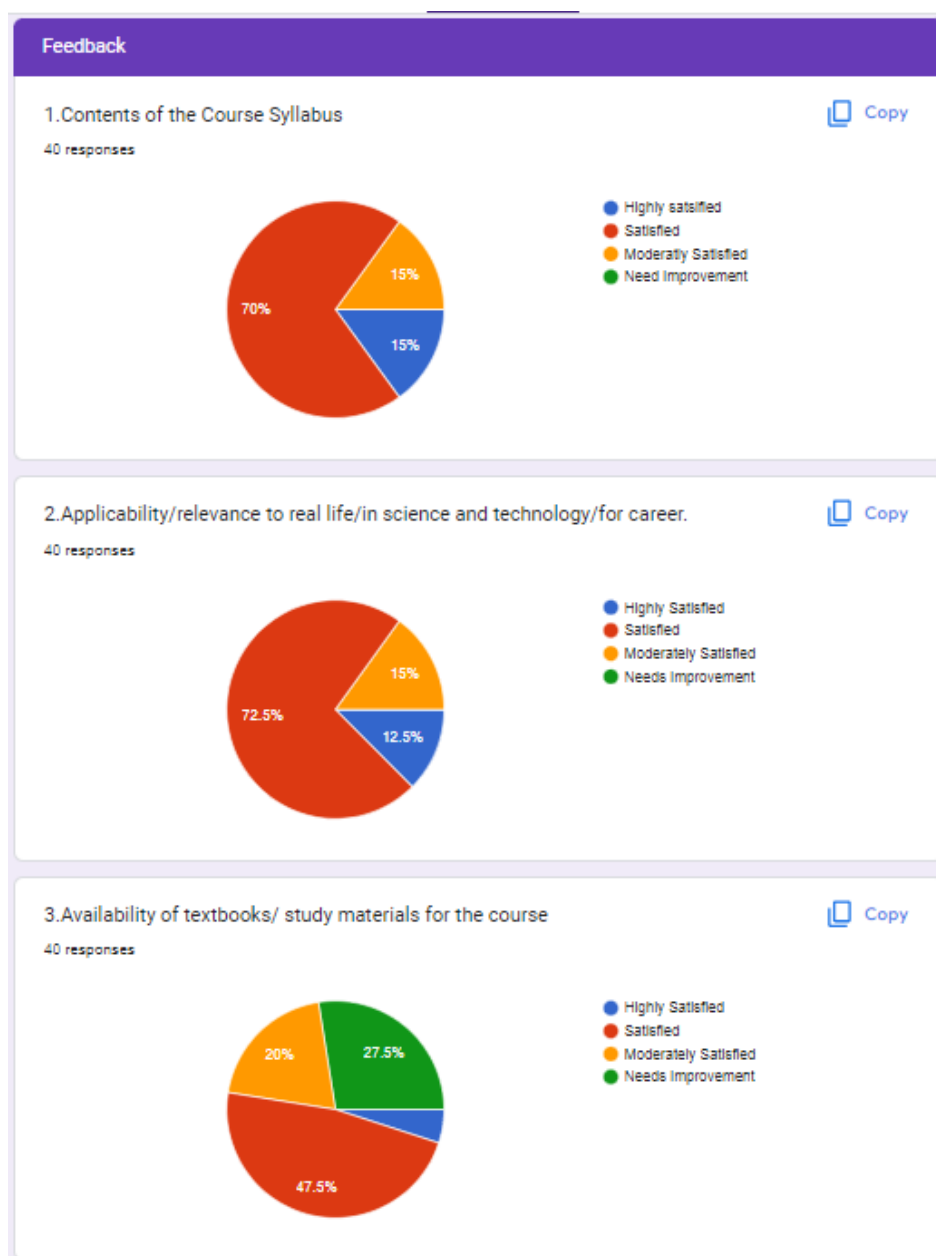

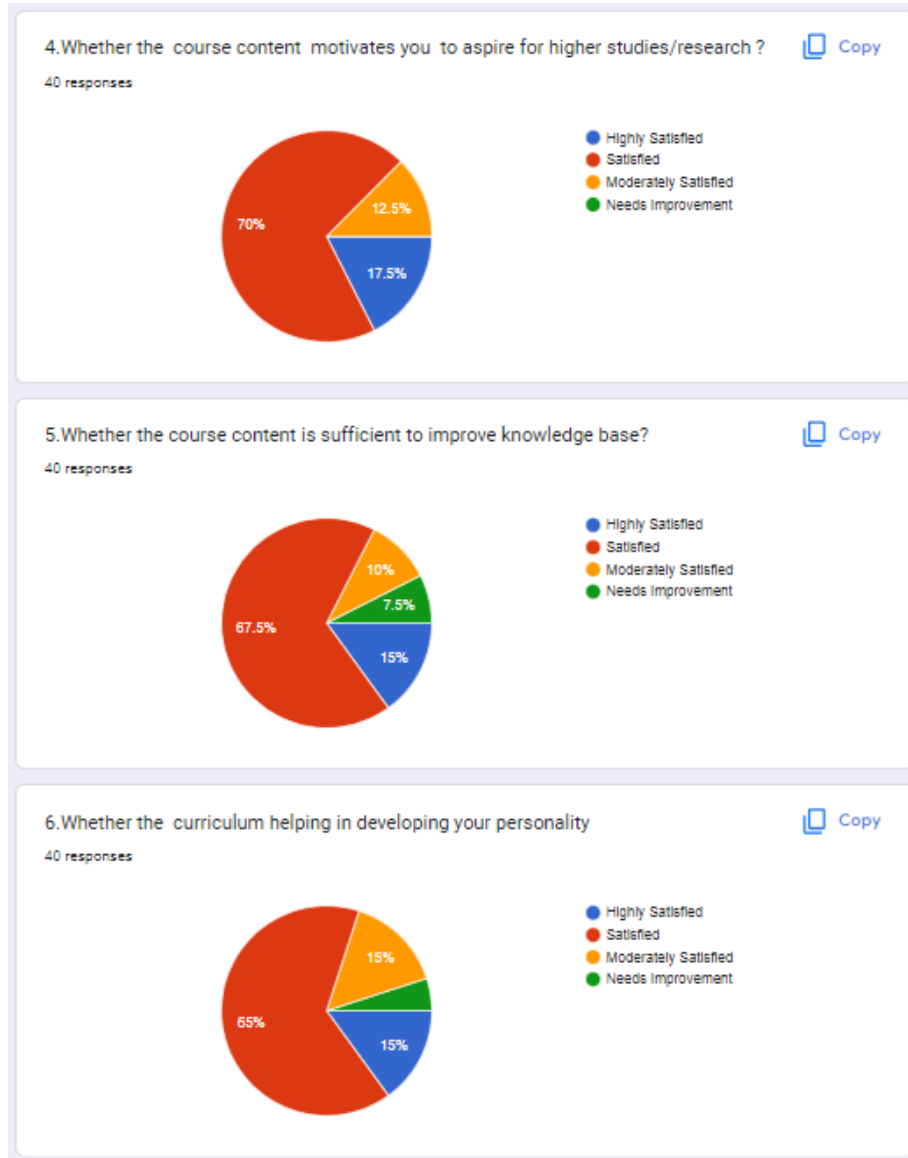
### Feedback from Students on Botany Curriculum

- 5) 42% of the students are happy that the curriculum is helping in improving their knowledge base and overall personality and balance of them are not so happy.

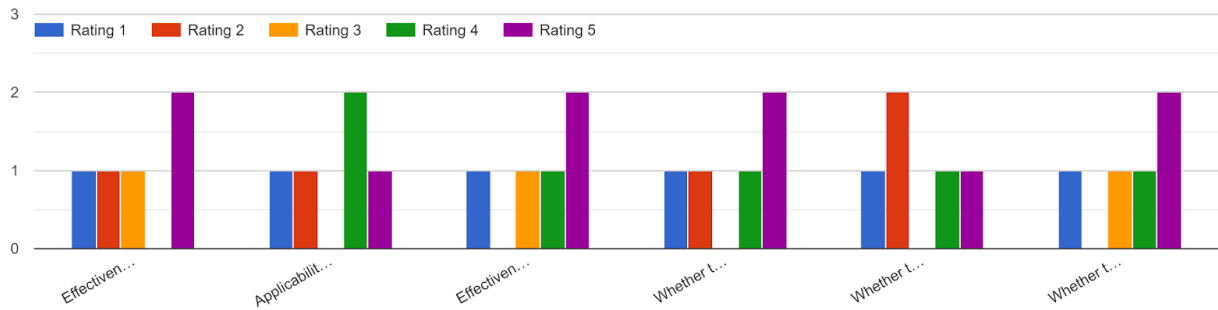
**Actions Taken**

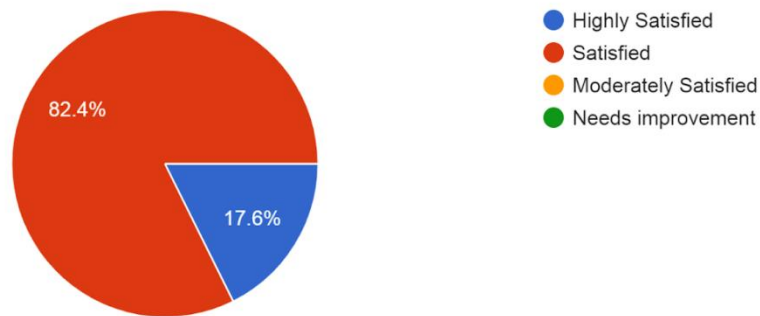

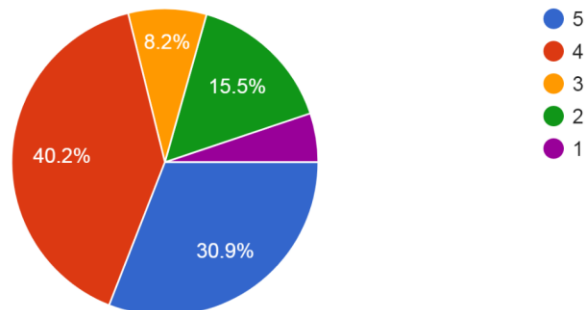


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1. 49.5% of the students are satisfied with the content of the syllabus and 22.7% of students are highly satisfied whereas 8.2% of students are moderately satisfied.

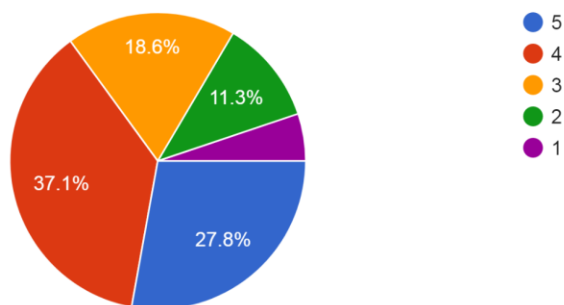

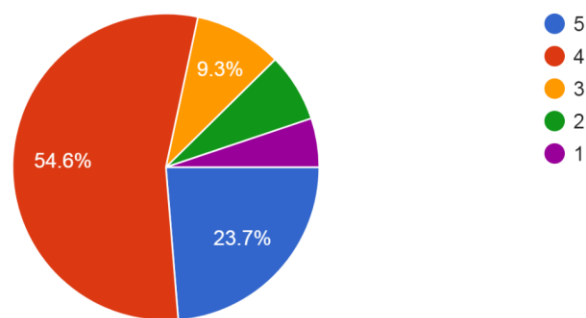

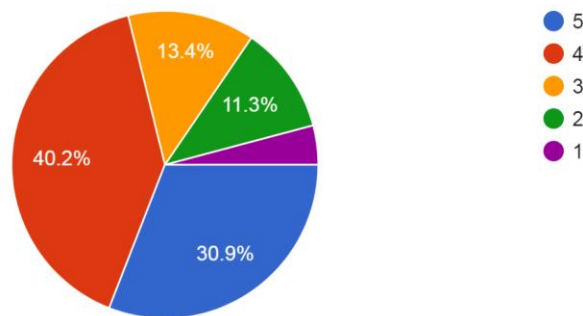

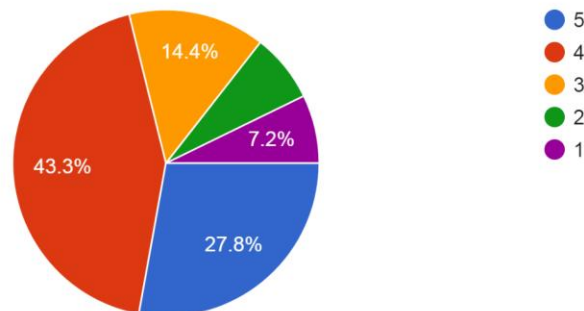

- As concerned with the study materials and textbooks the department has planned to purchase more reference books of different authors.

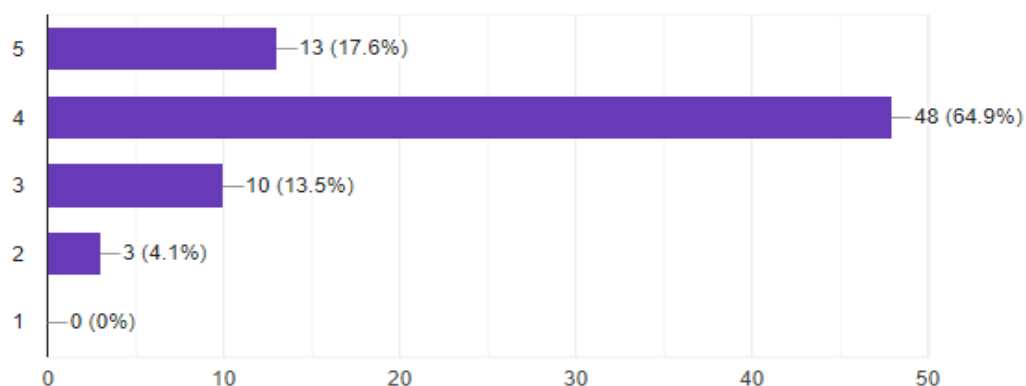

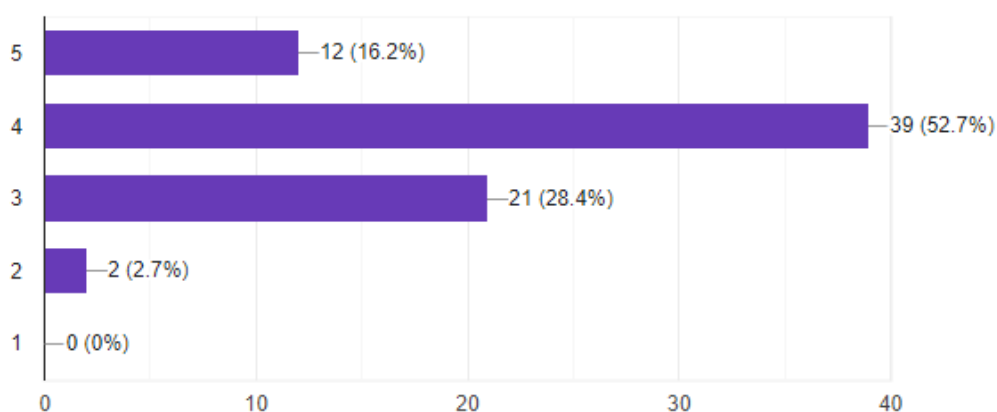

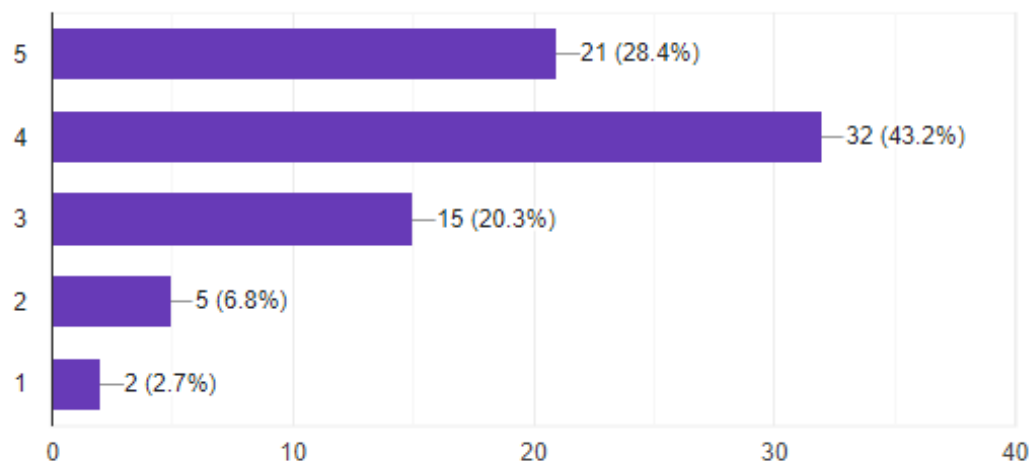

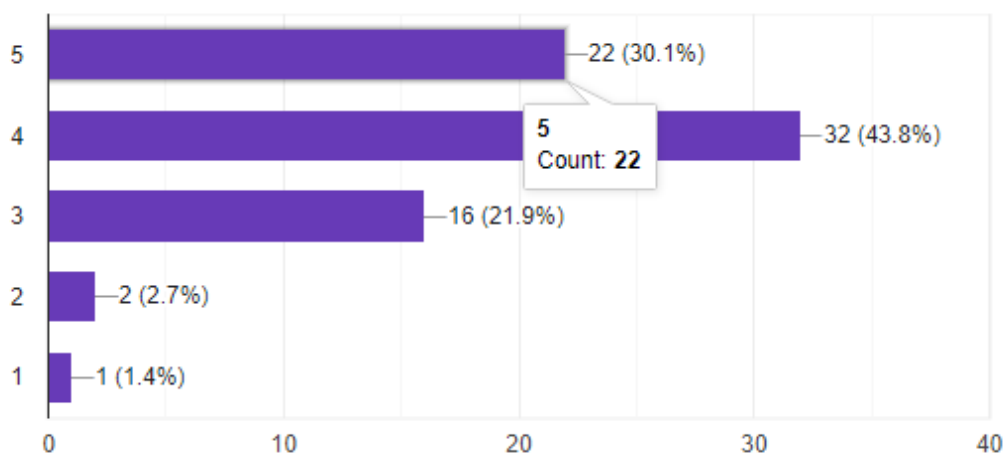

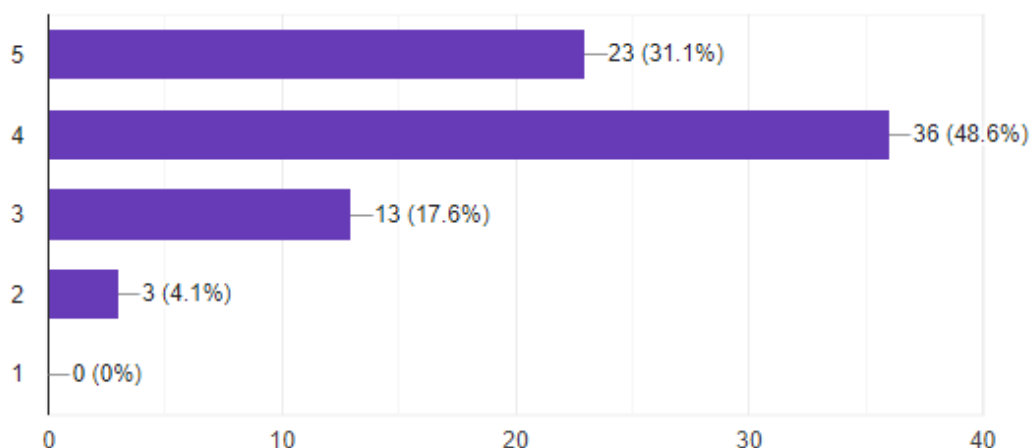

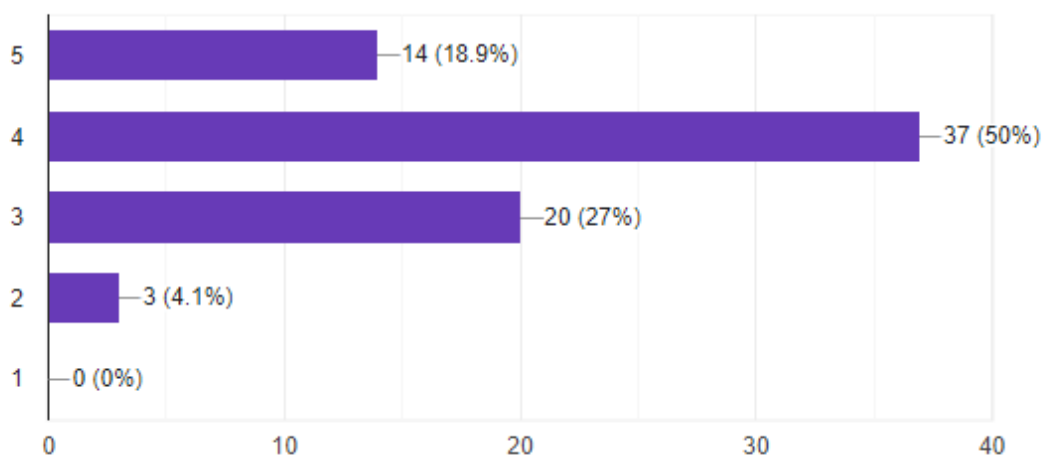

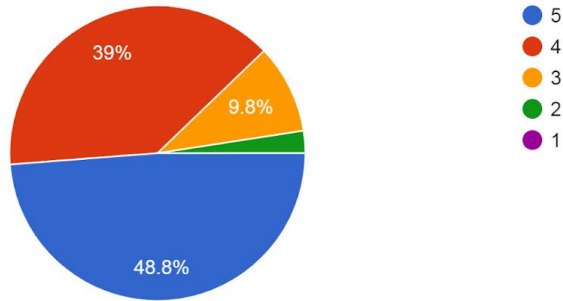

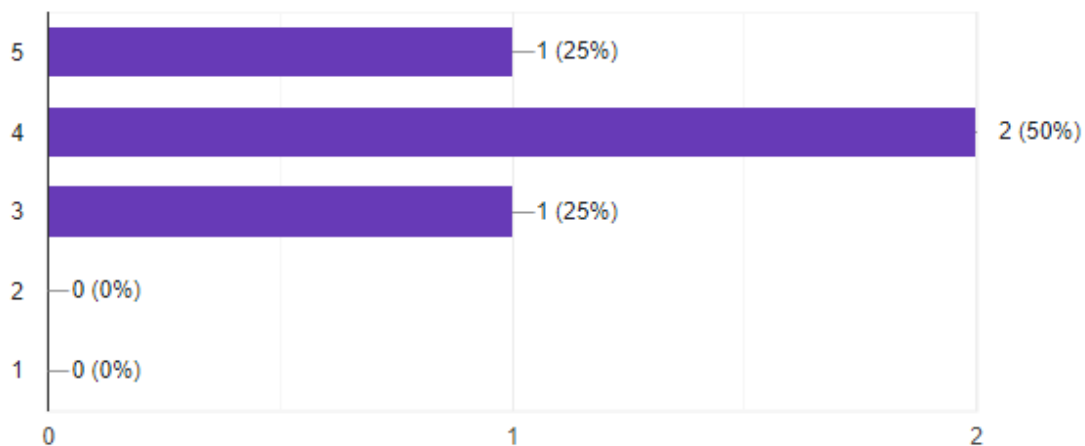

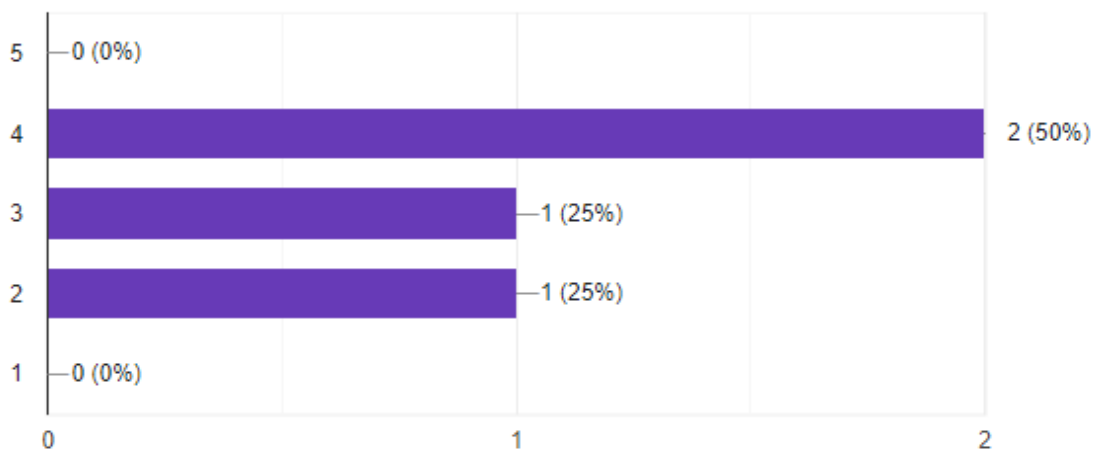

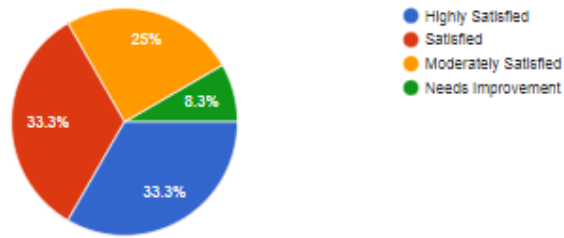

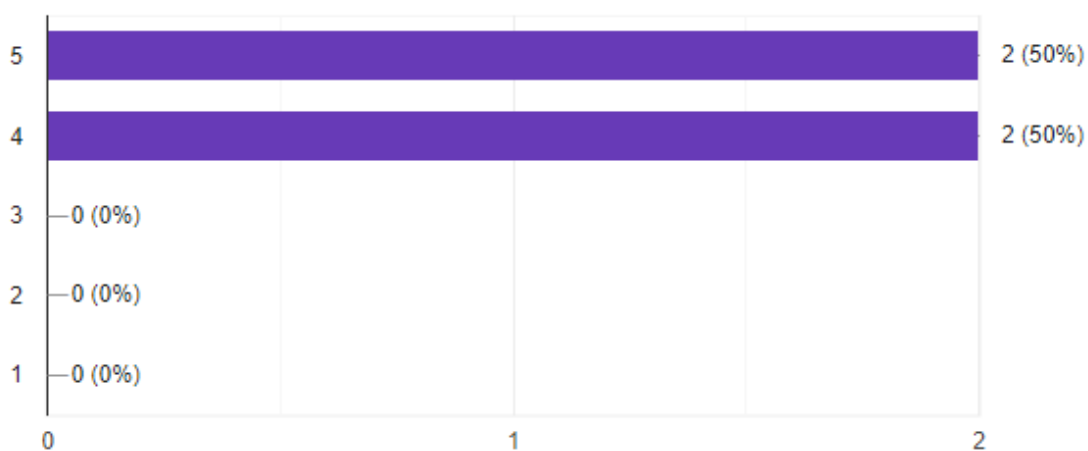

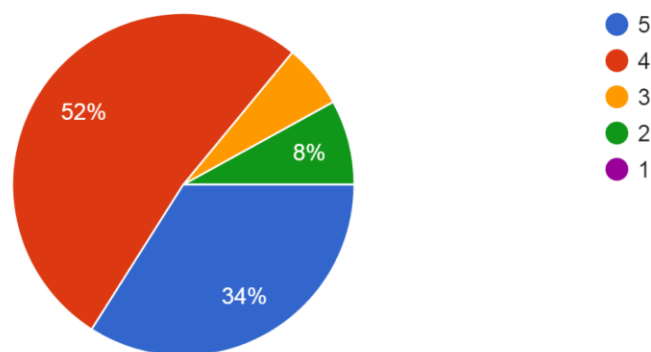

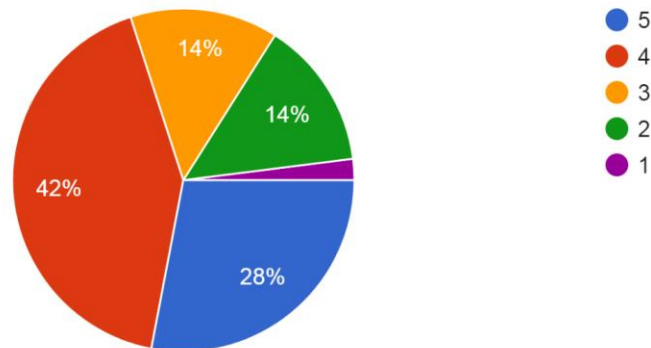

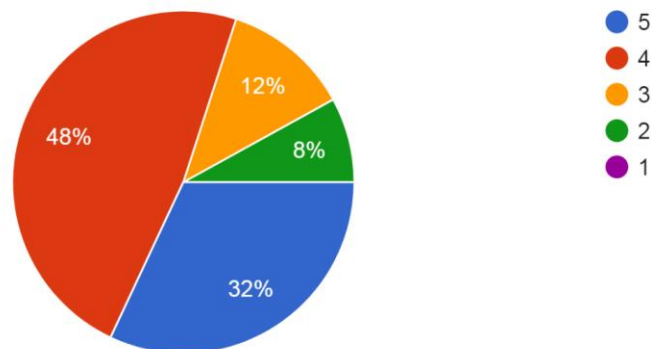

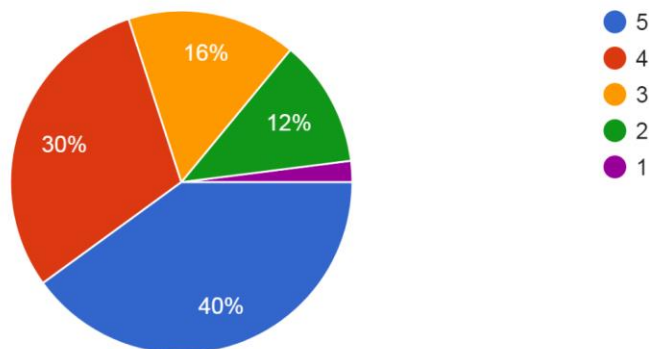
