

Abstract: Implementation of an integrated library management system by using koha is a very challengeable task for every librarian. This case study highlights the required technical infrastructure for koha and mentions a required database for exporting data to MARC format. The significance of the study is to elaborate the installation of koha in server computer and hosting the koha OPAC in online mode. In this case the study author encountered challenges such as availing static IP and port filtering in the network and also given possible solutions to overcome the problems. The lesson learnt and the experience gained would stand to implement a similar kind of system at various places. This study would be a better example to computerise the library and host the web OPAC with minimal cost.

Authors encountered many issues related to data migration and customisation of koha in the local scenario as per college needs. This paper tried to give some possible solutions related to MARC export and customisation part. The effort can be helpful in a similar conditions in different college environment.

These activities are not necessarily performed in traditional ways; the activities themselves are those traditionally associated with libraries; library automation may thus be distinguished from related fields such as information retrieval, automatic indexing and abstracting and automatic textual analysis".

A data converter must be aware about data security and accuracy while transfer and to provide an effective and efficient service to its clients (Hotiarachchi & Fernando 2010). This clearly advocates that safety measures should be taken to ensure effective management of library data.

Evolution of History of DVS Evening College Library

The DVS Evening College Library started library automation with Openbiblio Software in 2019. Later, it is found that Openbiblio software does not support the feature of Serial Management and Customised report generation. In 2021, the library planned to migrate the software from Openbiblio to Koha library management software.

Web Integrated Library Software (LIS)

As per Wikipedia KOHA is a web based ILS with a SQL database (MySQL) based, cataloguing data stored in MARC and accessible via Z39.50. The software platform is ease to redesignable, incorporatable and it can be translated into many languages. KOHA was initially developed in New Zealand by Katipo Communication Limited and first deployed in January 2001 for Horowhenua Library Trust (Pat, 2003). Although, it has been changing in many ways day by day. Also it supports the modules for Acquisitions, Circulation, Serial/Journal Management, Cataloguing, flexible reporting, multi lingual supports, variety format notices makes the koha a powerful Integrated Library Management System.
